A member benefit of the Indiana State Teachers Association (ISTA) and the National Education Association (NEA).

Attorney Referral Program

The Attorney Referral Program grants members two, free 30-minute legal consultations with an approved attorney each membership year. Remaining services in the five core areas listed below are 30 percent off attorney's fees.

What's Covered?

WILLS & ESTATES: Will preparation, estate planning, execution or administration of an estate and guardianship proceedings.

REAL ESTATE: Purchase or sale of residential property, disputes with landlords, property line controversies and zoning and land use regulations.

DOMESTIC RELATIONS: Annulment, divorce, separation, alimony, custody, child support, guardianship, adoption, paternity and name changes.

CONSUMER PROTECTION: Disputes with creditors or finance agencies and proceedings with retailers concerning defective merchandise.

TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS: Representation on offenses involving the potential loss of license, jail sentence or financial liability in excess of \$500.

Participating attorneys are not required to provide discounted rates with legal issues such as business dealings, bankruptcies, defense of IRS income tax preparations and defense of criminal violations (other than traffic violations).

How to Use?

Consult the participating attorneys list. When contacting a participating attorney, identify yourself as an ISTA member. Discuss fees and rates before services rendered.

As participating attorneys in the program, they should offer appointments outside of normal business hours, discuss fees before services rendered and accept payment installments.

Any court, filing or service fees and attorney out-of-pocket expenses are not automatically covered.

Who Can Participate?

ISTA/NEA members in all membership categories (along with their spouses, domestic partners and dependent children) are eligible for the NEA ARP benefit. If you have a legal issue outside of your state of residence, you can contact a participating attorney in the state where the legal matter resides.
